The Westborough Food Pantry welcomes new clients. You must be a Westborough resident and meet income requirements.

NEW CLIENT REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. You must be Westborough resident. You must provide one of the following:
  - A) A copy of your lease (most recent copy) with your name on the lease.
  - B) A recent rent receipt (last 30 days) – must show your name and apartment #.
2. You must provide a piece of mail with your name and address with a recent postmark (last 30 days)
3. You must provide a photo ID when registering, either a driver's license or passport.
4. You must provide a photo ID for all adults living with you.
5. You must provide a birth certificate or passport for any children less than 18 years old living with you.
6. You must provide income verification documents for everyone living with you that are working. They may include the following:
  - A) Current pay check stub
  - B) Social Security statement - (most current)
  - C) Unemployment statement - (most current)
  - D) Income tax return for previous year
  - E) Child Support or alimony payment records

The Westborough Food Pantry conducts two (2) verification sessions per year. The session in May checks income and residency. The session in October checks residency only. You will be given advance notice when these sessions will occur. You must complete these verification requirements to continue to receive food assistance.
